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Krishi Unnati Webcast



KVK Malappuram organised the webcast in connection with Krishi Unnati Mela at IARI, New Delhi on 17th March 2018 in KCAET auditorium, Tavanur. The programme was inaugurated by Sri. Assainar Haji, Ward Member, Tavanur Grama panchayat. Arrangements were made to view webcast of the Krishi Unnati mela inauguration by Hon. Prime Minister. The webcast was made from 12.15 pm till the end of the Prime Minister's speech. A seminar on 'water conservation in summer season' was conducted. 135 farmers witnessed the webcast and attended the seminar was also conducted.

Skill training on Agriculture Extension Service Provider

Two hundred hours long skill training on Agricultural Extension Service Provider based on the syllabus developed by ASCI following the norms of Ministry of Skill development and Entrepreneurship was organized for 20 trainees from 5th March to 31st March 2018. Theory and practical sessions were handled by experts from Kerala Agricultural University and various other

An exhibition organised in collaboration with Departments of Post Harvest Technology and FPME, KCAET, PFDC and Central Tuber Crops Research Institute, Trivandrum, was inaugurated by Dr. Santhi Mary Mathew, Dean, KCAET, Tavanur. State award winners of the district were honoured on the occasion. Seminars on Rice. Banana. Tuber crops and Vegetables were organised for the benefit of more than 600 farmers. Quiz competitions were held for students and farmers. Farmer Scientist interaction organised in connection with the program resulted in on the spot solution to farmer problems with respect to various crops.
